In April, PYC commemorated Kartini Day by organizing a social outreach program for female workers, particularly the blue-collar professions such as TransJakarta bus drivers and PPSU officers. During the event, participants received breast cancer awareness education and training on the SADARI self-examination method.

In May, we launched the latest episode of Energy Drink #36 "Is the Upstream Palm Oil Sector Ready to Support the Mandatory Biodiesel Policy?" on our YouTube channel. The episode explores the readiness of the upstream sector to support Indonesia's expanding biodiesel policy, as well as the impact of B40 and B50 mandates on palm oil supply, farmer welfare, and export continuity.

This quarter is also a special milestone as PYC celebrates its 9th anniversary. At the highlight of the anniversary, PYC presented the PYC Award to three inspiring figures: Elaine Low (Low Tuck Kwong Foundation), Anna Skarbek (Climateworks Centre) and Alexander Irwan (Ford Foundation) in recognition of their contributions in the fields of knowledge and innovation. The Best Costume Award was also given to guests who wore the best traditional Indonesian attire, as a tribute to the preservation of cultural values.

National Leadership Development and Consolidation Program "Achieving Sustainable Energy Self-Sufficiency in Indonesia"

On 7 May 2025, the National Resilience Institute of Indonesia (Lembaga Ketahanan Nasional/Lemhannas) held the P4N. This program aims to prepare national-level leaders with moral, ethical, and grounded national values. Filda C. Yusgiantoro, Chairperson of PYC, was invited as one of the speakers in the program. Filda presented a topic titled "Achieving Sustainable Energy Self-Sufficiency in Indonesia". In her statement, she emphasized that a just energy transition must include all stakeholders and ensure social protection for marginalized and vulnerable groups. She further highlighted the importance of collaboration among the government, private sector, NGOs, academia, and society to achieve sustainable energy self-sufficiency in Indonesia.

Prof. Purnomo Yusgiantoro Accompanied President Prabowo at the Opening of The 49th IPA Convex

Prof. Purnomo Yusgiantoro, Founder of Purnomo Yusgiantoro Center (PYC) and Special Advisor to the President of the Republic of Indonesia on Energy, accompanied President Prabowo Subianto at the opening ceremony of the 49th Indonesian Petroleum Association Convention and Exhibition (IPA Convex), held at ICE BSD On Wednesday, 21 May 2025.

His presence at the event was part of his role as the President's energy advisor. The opening ceremony was marked by the symbolic pressing of the LED Cube by President Prabowo, accompanied by Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Bahlil Lahadalia, IPA President Carole J. Gall, and Head of SKK Migas Djoko Siswanto.

Carrying the theme "Delivering Growth with Energy Resilience in a Lower Carbon Environment," IPA Convex 2025 served as a strategic platform to drive the transformation of Indonesia's energy sector toward greater resilience and sustainability.

In his speech, President Prabowo reaffirmed Indonesia's commitment to achieving energy self-sufficiency. He stated that the sovereignty of a nation depends on its ability to independently meet its food and energy needs.

He also emphasized that government policies must be grounded in common sense, offer real solutions, address existing challenges, and serve the interests of the Indonesian people and the nation.

The event was also attended by ambassadors from partner countries, several ministers from the Indonesia Maju Cabinet, and leaders of oil and gas companies from both domestic and international sectors.

PYC Chairperson, Filda C. Yusgiantoro, Moderated a Strategic Discussion on Accelerating Oil and Gas Projects at the 49th IPA Convention

The Chairperson of PYC, Filda C. Yusgiantoro, participated as a Moderator in The 49th IPA Convention & Exhibition during the Concurrent Session "Enhancing Project Delivery in Oil and Gas: Key Drivers of Maturation and Acceleration."

The session explored various challenges the oil and gas industry have been facing in recent years, including regulatory hurdles, infrastructure limitations, technological constraints, and skill gaps, all of which pose risks to achieving production targets and ensuring energy security. SKK Migas emphasized the importance of data in identifying the root causes of project delays, while Petronas and ExxonMobil shared innovations they have implemented to accelerate project execution. Cross-sector collaboration, including government, regulators, and contractors, were highlighted as crucial to ensuring smooth project delivery and boosting oil and gas production.

The session featured speakers from various institutions, including Mr. Taufan Marhaendrajana (Deputy of Exploitation, SKK Migas), Mr. Muhammad Shaufi Dahlan (Senior General Manager, Wells Development Division Upstream, PETRONAS), Mr. Muhammad Nurdin (Senior Vice President, ExxonMobil Cepu Limited), and Mr. Gary Archer (Director, Performance and Sustainability, SLB OneSubsea).

PYC Chairperson Attends Australia-Indonesia Energy Transition Dialogue

On 17 June 2025, Filda C. Yusgiantoro, Chairperson of Purnomo Yusgiantoro (PYC), attended the Fifth Australia-Indonesia Energy Transition Policy Dialogue to accelerate the clean energy transition through collaborative research, policy support, and institutional cooperation. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed by Climateworks Centre, CPD, IESR, IISD, IRID, and PYC. Speakers included Deputy Minister of Industry Faisol Riza, Anna Skarbek (CEO, Climateworks), and Andrew Hudson (CEO of CPD). The dialogue explored potential collaborations in critical mineral development, EV battery supply chains, and regional climate initiatives, aiming to build momentum toward a just and sustainable energy transition.
